


The farming of bones plot summary guide printable



George Orwell – Animal Farm

Plot Overview

Old Major, a prize-winning boar, gathers the animals of the Manor Farm for a meeting in the big barn. He tells them of a dream he has had in which all animals live together with no human beings to oppress or control them. He tells the animals that they must work toward such a paradise and teaches them a song called "Beasts of England," in which his dream vision is lyrically described. The animals greet Major's vision with great enthusiasm. When he dies only three nights after the meeting, three younger pigs—Snowball, Napoleon, and Squealer—formulate his main principles into a philosophy called Animalism. Late one night, the animals manage to defeat the farmer Mr. Jones in a battle, running him off the land. They rename the property Animal Farm and dedicate themselves to achieving Major's dream. The cart-horse Boxer devotes himself to the cause with particular zeal, committing his great strength to the prosperity of the farm and adopting as a personal maxim the affirmation "I will work harder." At first, Animal Farm prospers. Snowball works at teaching the animals to read, and Napoleon takes a group of young puppies to educate them in the principles of Animalism. When Mr. Jones reappears to take back his farm, the animals defeat him again, in what comes to be known as the Battle of the Cowshed, and take the farmer's abandoned gun as a token of their victory. As time passes, however, Napoleon and Snowball increasingly quibble over the future of the farm, and they begin to struggle with each other for power and influence among the other animals. Snowball concocts a scheme to build an electricity-generating windmill, but Napoleon solidly opposes the plan. At the meeting to vote on whether to take up the project, Snowball gives a passionate speech. Although Napoleon gives only a brief retort, he then makes a strange noise, and nine attack dogs—the puppies that Napoleon had confiscated in order to "educate"—burst into the barn and chase Snowball from the farm. Napoleon assumes leadership of Animal Farm and declares that there will be no more meetings. From that



Sometimes, fewer than half of them survived the trip. In the colonies, they worked and lived alongside the whites. They used the idea to justify all past, present and future exploitation and abuse of black people, Indians, and later, other "people of color." The final step in this process was that black people lost all their rights and became the property of the slave owners. These are elements common to most citations. Every aspect of the trade and of slavery became even more brutal. The British tried several ways of dealing with the labor shortage. The purpose was to separate whites and blacks in order to control both. Laws were passed to punish whites who had black friends, or who ran away with black people, and vice versa. The almost dreamlike pace of Danticat's second novel (*Breath, Eyes, Memory*, 1994) and the measured narration by the protagonist, Amabelle Desir, at first give no indication that this will be a story of furious violence and nearly unbearable loss. Because racism (then and now) is against the direct interests of the working class, many workers, both slave and "free," continued to unite in rebellions against slavery. In the 1660s all this began to change -- drastically. At this stage, the concept of race needed to be made up. While this novel is deeply sad, it is infused with Danticat's fierce need to bear witness, coupled with a knowledge that "life can be a strange gift" even when memory makes endurance a difficult task.--From Publishers Weekly Page 2 "Why do I have to cite my sources?" When you do research, you work with other people's ideas as well as your own. This is an integral part of research, to combine your ideas with the ideas of others and create something new. By using the core elements, any item can be cited, regardless of format. The image on the left shows the elements. Please play close attention to the punctuation after each element. The profits from buying and selling African workers, combined with the rape of gold and silver from South and Central America, provided the capital to drive the engine of the industrial revolution. It was also legal to increase their seven-year contract as punishment for various misdeeds. But slave labor is not the usual form of labor under capitalism: wage labor is. And why is it that the slaves were Africans? When you cite your sources, you tell your readers about where you found some of the inspiration for your work, and you credit those who inspired you, or those whose work you used. At this stage, most indentured servants did not even live until the end of their seven year contract. They had to be trained to. When different groups went to war, people who were captured became slaves - not for life, and not without rights, but still slaves. They had made a decision to base the American economic system on human slavery, and the supply of labor from Africa was cheap and plentiful. Slavery of the early, pre-capitalist type existed in west Africa at that time. They were forced to work without wages to pay off their passage to America from England, usually for seven years. In 1662 came the "principal of heredity," which declared that, legally, if the mother was a black slave, the child would also be a slave from birth. Then lifetime servitude for black servants became law. A crucial concept for the MLA style is the concept of containers. Also, when you cite your sources, you help your readers find those sources if they wish to read more about the ideas presented in your work. "How do I decide when to cite a source?" Whenever you use information from articles, books, interviews, etc., you must credit the authors of those works by citing the sources. When the information you're using is your own idea, or when the information is common knowledge (for example, that Thomas Jefferson was president of the United States), then you do not need to cite. There was no barrier between white and black servants; their common enemy created an intense solidarity, which overcame the superficial differences in language and cultural habits. Black and white people were punished by torture, maiming and death for breaking these laws. The main one, at first, was indentured servitude. The bosses eventually "persuaded" many white workers to identify with their masters instead of their black brothers and sisters. This training was ruthless and carefully planned, and continues to this day! The legislatures, the churches, the courts and the press were all used in the campaign. At first, some plantation owners began to hold certain Africans for life, rather than for seven years. "What if I take the information and reward it?" Rewording something is called "paraphrasing." If you paraphrase, you still have to cite your source, because the ideas you are using belong to another person. British and other European merchants offered money to purchase captured slaves, and they found the African slave owning rulers willing to sell. "The truth is that skin color was an excuse for racism, not the cause of it." Blacks and whites did not view each other as different races. It also made it possible for the ruling class to make huge profits off the backs of poor white workers and farmers who were divided from their black brothers and sisters, and confused by racism about the cause of their poverty. When slavery developed in the "New World" in the sixteen and seventeen hundreds, it was a new type of slavery. They lived, worked, and married together. The plantation owners and the colonial government violently disciplined these workers. The Virginia legislature, in 1672, defined a black person: anyone with one black grandparent. Note: This playbook uses the core elements to format the most common types of citations, but it is recommended that everyone spend some time learning how to put the elements together to format any citation. People were packed like sardines into the holds of ships for two to three months. England cut back on white emigration. Husbands, wives and children were separated. It was an integrated raid, and one of the main organizers was John Brown, who was white. Once they arrived in America, they were auctioned off to buyers. They also faced the problem of labor discipline because it was easy for workers to leave the plantations or escape to the Indians. They went through the same hell, from the boat passage to the auction block to the beatings and harsh conditions. British capitalist states also did not think of each other as belonging to separate "races." These laws represented the beginning of the idea of racism. White workers as well as black slaves became victims of it. So why did slavery develop in the Americas? "Racist ideas were forced on the working class by one hundred years of violence and propaganda." The capitalists made racism an essential part of their system, but they never succeeded in squashing the opposition to it. The lovers each have poignant memories of parental deaths, and other deaths enter the narrative easily, subtly presaging the slaughter that is to come. The capitalists who devised racism clearly knew what they were doing. They often ran away together, and on several occasions they rebelled together. This made slavery possible. "So what do I do if I paraphrase?" When you're going to paraphrase, introduce this in a way that makes it clear the ideas belong to someone else. The event which touched off the Civil War was the Harper's Ferry raid. Under this system, unemployed people from England were convinced to come to America or were kidnapped. The shipmasters and merchants who brought white laborers to the colonies also went to Africa to get laborers. Haitians in the DR, always regarded as foreigners, are "an orphaned people, a group of waywajie, wayfarers." When a military-led assault against them does erupt, it is a surprise, however, and as Amabelle barely survives a massacre by soldiers and an equally bloodthirsty civilian population, the narrative acquires the unflinching clarity of a documentary. Runaways were punished by hanging, burning, being staked in the sun or shot. For example, you could say, "Peterson argues that..." or "In her book, the author mentions several times that...." Although most historians today say that racism came about because Europeans were "naturally" prejudiced against Africans because of their skin color, the truth is that skin color was an excuse for racism, not the cause of it. This carefully planned raid was intended to be the beginning of an army of escaped slaves and a guerrilla war in the south. What was a child whose parents were different colors? Whites in general still had not learned to be racist. This idea was very profitable, so it didn't bother the capitalist rulers of the colonies that it was a blatant lie. "British capitalists made a conscious decision to base the American economic system on human slavery." The slave trade was immensely profitable. If you don't, you're committing plagiarism, which is both lying and stealing. It was slavery within the capitalist economy. These were white, English people: racism had nothing to do with it. They openly disobeyed the laws. Although they were defeated by the overwhelmingly superior force of the government, there were hundreds of slave revolts in the United States, a great many of which involved white workers and farmers. But in a society which until then had paid almost no attention to skin color, a number of questions had to be answered: what was a black person? When an element is unavailable, it is simply skipped. She and her lover, Sébastien Onus, are Haitians who have crossed the border. White and black rebels were beheaded, and their heads put on poles along the roads as warnings. The truth, hidden by the bosses, is that racist ideas and practices were forced on the working class by one hundred years of violence, laws and propaganda. When the British began to develop profitable plantations in their American colonies they faced a serious shortage of workers. As racism came to be more accepted, conditions for whites got even worse. Europe became the top dog in the world based on the enslavement of American Indians and Africans. Laws were passed against interracial dating and marriage - which people ignored for more than a century. The idea was that whites were superior to blacks. Despite all this, rebellion and unity continued. It is very important that you give credit where credit is due, and this is one reason you need to cite your sources. The ruling class began to offer rewards to each group to betray the other: Indians were offered bounties for betraying black runaways, blacks were given minor rewards for helping to fight Indians, whites were used against both. The setting, the Dominican Republic in 1937, when dictator Trujillo was beginning his policy of genocide, is a clue, however, to the events that Amabelle relates. In addition to illuminating a shameful, little known chapter of history, Dantical gives us fully realized characters who endure their lives with dignity, a sensuously atmospheric setting and a perfectly paced narrative written in prose that is lushly poetic and erotic, specifically detailed (the Haitians were betrayed by their inability to pronounce "parsley") and starkly realistic. Millions of black people were murdered by capitalism in this process. Amabelle is a servant to a patrician family, while Sébastien endures the brutal conditions of work in the cane fields. "Africans joined whites as indentured servants and went through the same hell..." For several decades, the Africans brought to North America joined whites as indentured servants. It was just plain capitalist greed. The plantations system grew, forcing them off any land they might farm, and out of any jobs they might get. But the colonial rulers still faced a big problem: both whites and blacks resisted the new system. To do this, more laws were passed. At this time, the colonial ruling class (plantation owning families like the Washingtons, Jeffersons, Mathers and Byrds: the "fathers of our country") began to legalize slavery. A container is the larger work that includes the source. What was a white person? The industrial revolution was beginning so more workers were needed in the factories at home. When people died, they were tossed overboard.
